

SUMMER PROGRAMME

Jul 2008 - Sep 2008

The summer season starts with a cruise for all comers on the South Coast of England to Penzance, to celebrate the ship's pirate connection, then round Land's End to Dublin. Finally across the Irish Sea to Liverpool, via the Isle of Man.

PELICAN then takes part in the full series of Tall Ship Races round the north of Scotland to Måløy in Norway, followed by Bergen and through the North Sea to Den Helder in the Netherlands. Here the priority is to young people but a quarter of berths are available to 25s and over to enjoy the festival atmosphere and lively competition.

Finally, crossing the Channel to the Thames, through the famous Barrier to Canary Wharf and West India Dock. A chance to enjoy the highlife of London. Departing London, pass the White Cliffs of Dover, the Sussex Downs en route for Weymouth with a chance to visit France or the Channel Islands.

WHY IS PELICAN DIFFERENT?

The square rigger PELICAN of LONDON is privately owned and operated to make the widest choice of tall ship sailing available to all ages on the world stage.

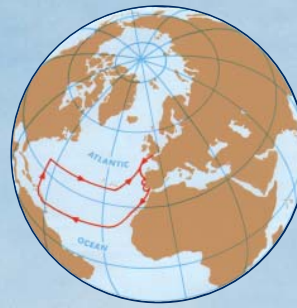
Accredited by the Association of Sail Training Organisations (ASTO) and based in UK, her programme includes three month voyages across the Atlantic with shorter exclusive holiday cruises in the Caribbean, and European waters on return. A circumnavigation of the world is planned for later years.

PELICAN has no equivalent amongst square riggers, she sets 11 sails on three masts - a rig derived from the Barbary Coast pirate ships, the most successful corsairs of the Mediterranean for two centuries. With a beautiful clipper hull this gives her a unique performance to windward and a great turn of speed.



Originally French-built in 1946 to work in the Arctic, PELICAN has been meticulously reconstructed from keel to masthead. Although classed as a Sail Training Ship under the British flag, all cabins are en suite and temperature controlled for world wide operation. The run of her wooden decks, bronze fittings and traditional rigging emphasise her quality and adaptability to many roles.

Her programme is therefore diverse, one of challenge and discovery on long training voyages with relaxation and good living the predominant feature on holiday cruises. Corporate events and team building can be arranged in the summer months. However, adventure and fun are at the heart of what PELICAN offers, year round.



MAIDEN OUTBOUND TRANS ATLANTIC VOYAGE

Sep 2007 - Dec 2007

Join PELICAN at Weymouth on her very first training voyage across the Atlantic (for ages 17 or over). Everyone signs on as working crew and takes a full part in every aspect of life at sea. Call at Portugal and Spain, following the sun to the Canaries. Further south pick up the NE Trade winds off the Cape Verdes. By now you know the ropes; time for study and observation.

Experience is rewarded by increased responsibility; yet interdependence remains a way of life on board. A fortnight later landfall at Barbados. Then a month off the beaten track, exploring the superb Caribbean islands from Grenada to Antigua. Meet the people, discover the spices, snorkel the reefs and explore the rain forest. You may fly home for Christmas but you could be invited to stay on and join the permanent crew at no charge.



PROJECT WORK ON THE LONG VOYAGES

Directed research will concentrate on observable marine phenomena, nature and the world around us. Other subjects include the history and culture of the countries to be visited. Everyone gets involved. Instruction in seamanship and navigation is given by the permanent crew, and with additional effort, you can obtain RYA qualifications or progress towards the Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award.
